European Language Grid (ELG)

- Iz flajera:
 - In January 2019, the three-year EU-funded innovation project European Language Grid (ELG) was launched. The aim of the project is to develop the first – and primary – platform for European Language Technologies (LT), and to establish it as the digital marketplace for LT solutions.
 - The ELG will enable the industrial and academic Language Technology community to deposit and upload their commercial and non-commercial technologies as well as data sets into the platform, to deploy them, and to connect them with other resources.

The European Language Platform

- ELG develops a scalable cloud platform, providing, in an easy-to-integrate way, access to hundreds of commercial and non-commercial LT for all languages.
- Through the ELG platforms, companies that develop LT solutions, academic and research organizations as well as individual researchers can gain visibility by showcasing their practical results.

The European Language Platform

- The ELG platform will be populated with:
 - Functional Language Technology (including remote services),
 - Tools and software packages,
 - Datasets and resources,
 - Information about the wider European Language Technology landscape (the “Yellow Pages” of European LT)

Open Calls for Pilot Projects

- ELG will publish two open calls for demonstrator pilot projects. These approx. 15-20 pilots will broaden the portfolio of LT and demonstrate the usefulness of ELG as a technological platform. Implementing innovative applications, the the pilot projects will make use of ELG services and data sets and they will also contribute their own services and data sets back to the ELG. Furthermore, we will gain valuable user feedback from projects that use ELG services and datasets.

Open Calls for Pilot Projects

- Proposals for pilot projects will be peer-reviewed, the accepted projects will be supervised by ELG Pilot Board, which will provide a forum in which the ELG project partners can discuss the progress of the pilots, exchange feedback and monitor results

- Estimated project runtime:
 - 9-12 meseci
- Funding per project:
 - Do 200.000 evra

Šta je još rečeno o ovim projektima

- Očekuje se da se u okviru projekta razviju resursi, alati ili servisi koji će postati dostupni preko ELG platforme ili da se nešto radi i razvija koristeći resurse, alate ili servise koji postoje na platformi.
- Posle poziva će biti oko 2 meseca vremena da se predlog projekta podnese;
- Predlog neće biti komplikovan, recimo 5-10 strana.
 - Podnosiće se preko **Fundingbox**, šta god da je to.

Šta je još rečeno o ovim projektima

- Očekivani budžet po projektu bi trebalo da bude 100.000 EUR < B < 200.000 EUR
- Dinamika plaćanja:
 - 50% po potpisivanju ugovora
 - 35% po obavljenom **eksperimentu**
 - 15% po **integraciji** i **diseminaciji**
- Trajanje projekta 9-12 meseci
- U projektu učestvuje **jedna** organizacija
 - Prvi poziv, oko 6-15 projekata, trajanje 9-12 meseci
 - Drugi poziv 4-15 projekata, trajanje 8-11 meseci, min 30% budžeta za drugi poziv.

Šta su još naše mogućnosti

- ELG okuplja tzv. National Competence Centres (NCC);
 - Iz Srbije, to je FilF i Cvetana Krstev
 - Svaki NCC ima u budžetu brojekta 8.000 evra koja može da upotrebi za sledeće:
 - **Prisustvovanje sastanku** (kao što je bio ovaj u Briselu, do 600 evra).
 - Očekuju se još dva sastanka, jedan u vreme LREC-a, sledeći u vreme narednog META-Foruma, jesen 2020.
 - Možemo da organizujemo **dve radionice** (workshop), svaka do 3.000 EUR
 - Organizovanje nije komplikovano, treba najaviti o čemu će biti reči, plaćanje unazad.
 - Uskoro će se potpisivati ugovori pa će ovo biti jasnije, ali treba razmišljati kako možemo ovo da upotrebimo.
